#### Eligibility Requirements

- Have earned a Doctor of Pharmacy degree from an accredited college of pharmacy at the commencement of the program (July 2024).
- Authorized to work in the US without BeiGene sponsorship.

#### Qualifications

- Excellent written/verbal communication skills
- Ability to work efficiently in a remote environment
- Ability to understand, analyze, and apply clinical and medical information
- Ability to work independently and proactively
- Ability to work collaboratively within a cross-cultural team and build effective partnerships
- Flexible, adaptable, and able to work efficiently Analytical - ability to logically break down scenarios, carry out
- diagnostics, and develop situations
- Strong organizational and project management skills with a high level of attention to detail and time management skills Commitment to integrity and high standards in self and peers

- Letter of Intent

- Writing Sample (no more than 1-2 pages; e.g., drug information response, journal club assessment, etc)
